## **Installation Instructions:**

**Safety Warning:** Before you attempt any installation, make sure your rifle is unloaded. Also, before starting, remove the bolt and magazine from the rifle.

- **Step 1:** Remove the cheek piece from the rear stock using a hex wrench (Metric size 5).
- **Step 2:** Put the selector switch on "Fire", depress the bolt release, and insert the action wrench as if you were inserting the bolt into the action.
- **Step 3:** Clamp the barrel in a vise and use a ¾" or 19mm socket wrench to turn the action off or onto the barrel. If installing a barrel, use a torque wrench to set the proper torque. Sako does not publish torque figures for barrel installation, however, 100ft/lbs seems to be a commonly accepted figure.
